# Jesus and Nicodemus

John 3:1-21

- Nicodemus was a ruler of the Jews, a Pharisee. Most of the Pharisees did not believe that Jesus was sent by God, but Nicodemus did.
- Nicodemus came to Jesus by night to talk to Him about the kingdom of God.
- He said to Jesus, "Teacher, we know that God sent You, for no one can do the miracles You do unless God is with Him." Jesus told him that he needed to be born again by the Spirit of God, by believing in God's Son that was sent to die for the whole world, in order to enter the kingdom of heaven.

- What kind of work did Nicodemus do?
- When did Nicodemus visit Jesus?
- Why did Nicodemus visit Jesus?
- How was Nicodemus different from the other Pharisees?

- What did Jesus tell Nicodemus he must do to go to heaven?
- Why did God send His Son into the world? (John 3:16)
- Will God be in heaven when people go there?

### What does it mean:

- Did the Pharisees believe it was more important for people to obey their rules or to love and obey God?
- Jesus said, "No man can see the Kingdom of God unless he is 'born again.'"
- What does it mean to be "born again."?
- Do you know you must be "born again" to have your sins forgiven?

### What does it mean to me:

- Why did God send His Son into the world?
- Do you want to live with God in heaven when your life is over?
- Would you like to ask Jesus to be your Savior so you can live with Him in heaven?
- You can do that by praying to Him right now.

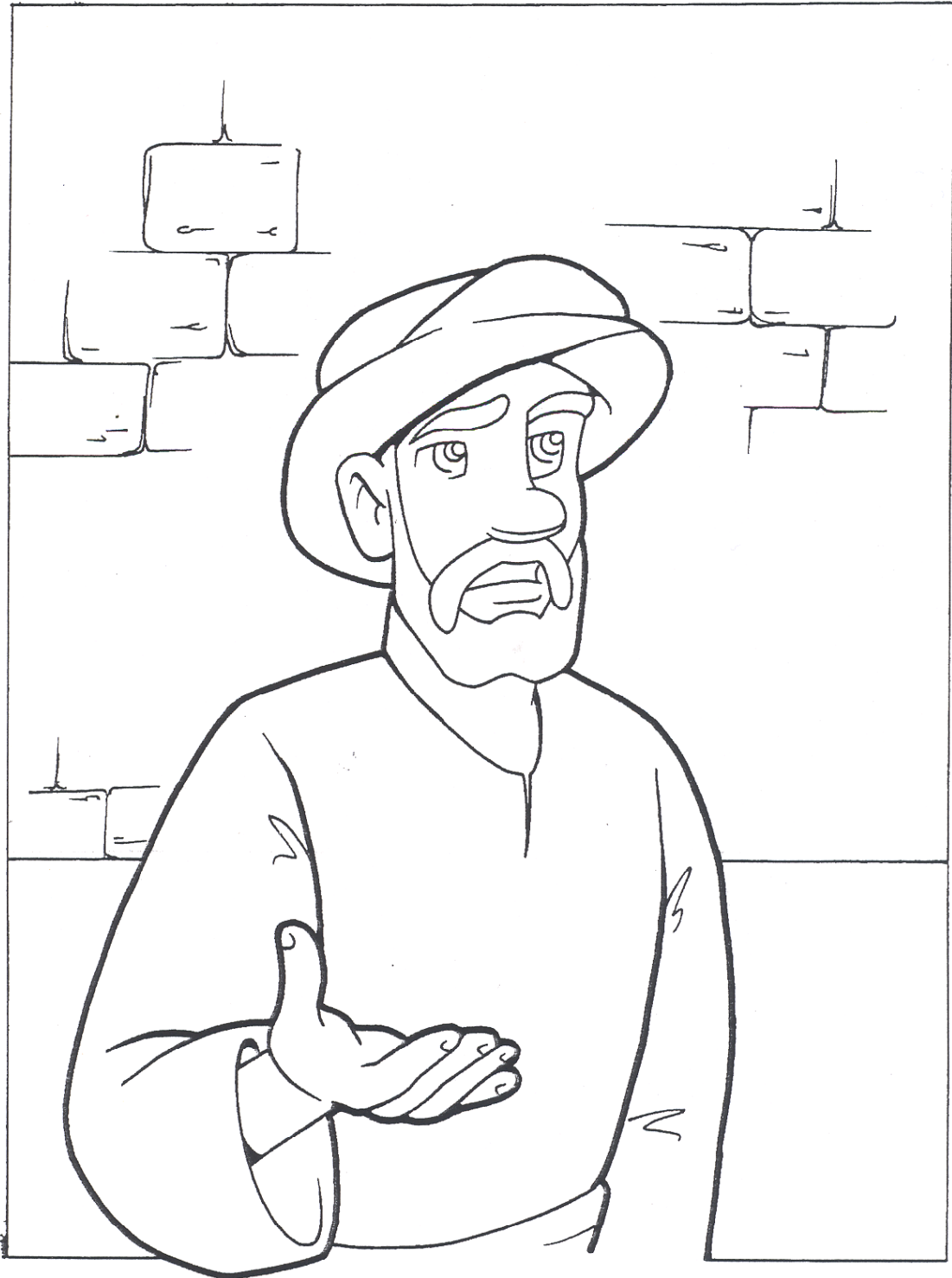

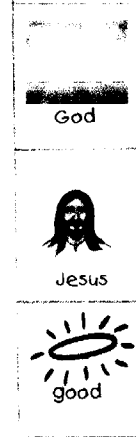
