- Do you talk with Jesus?

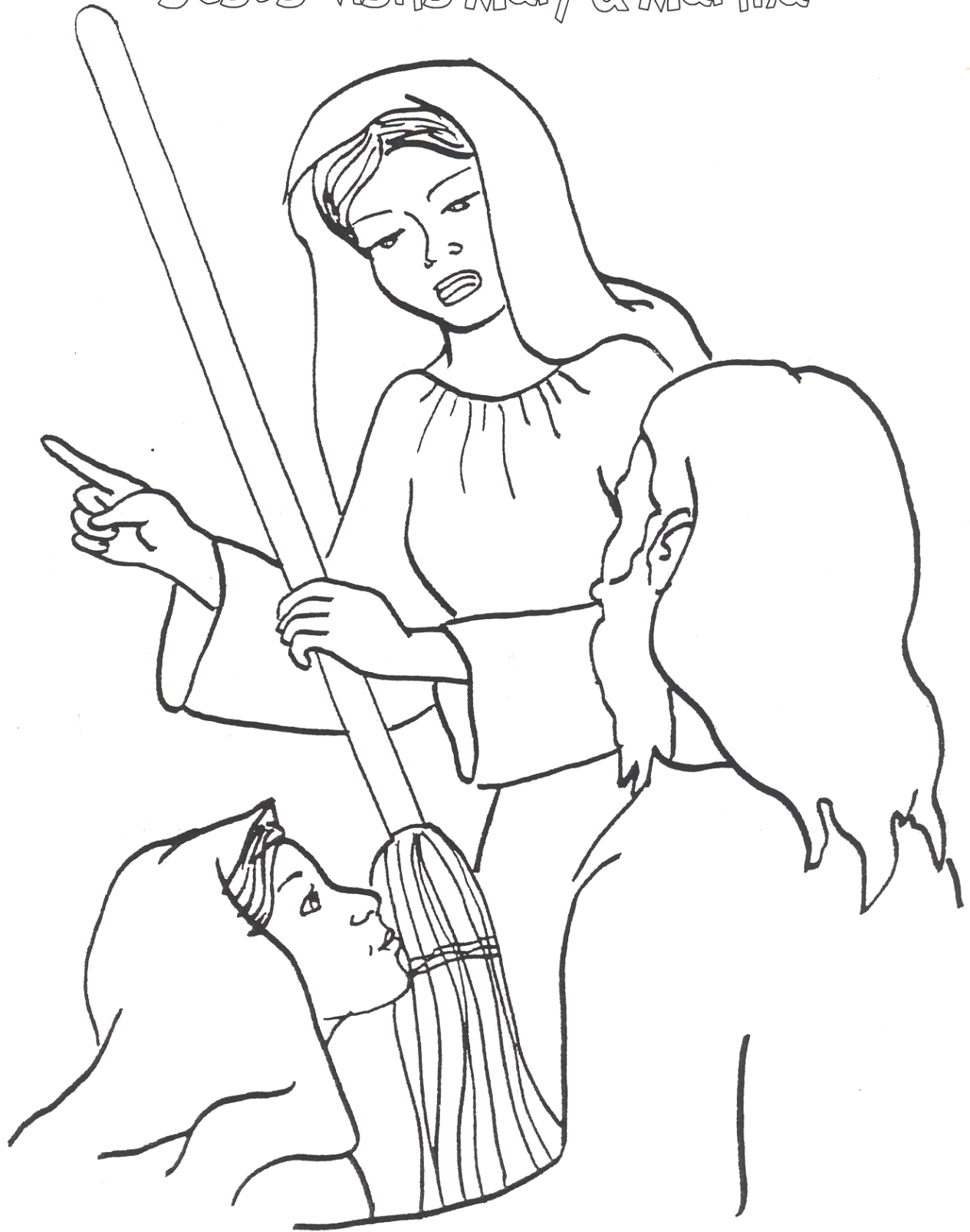

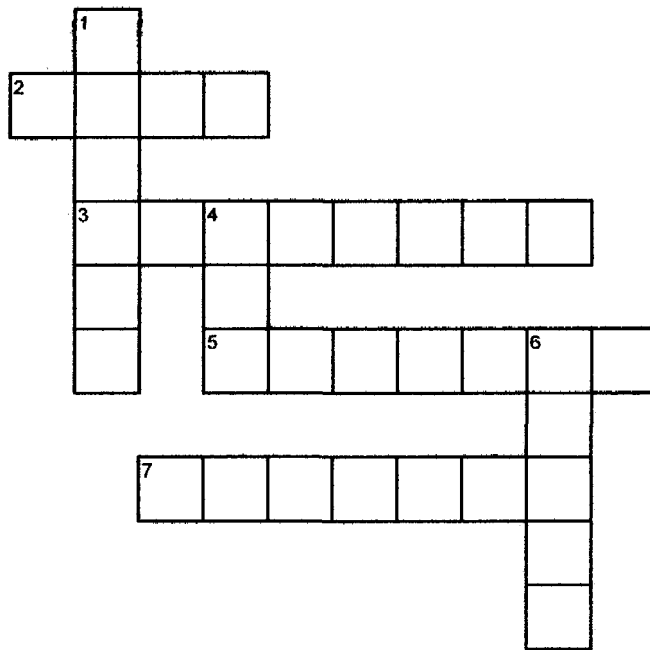
