John 6:1-14

- After Jesus had been teaching all day, the people were very hungry. Jesus told
 his disciples to give them food. The disciples said they did not have enough
 money to buy food for all the people.
- Andrew brought a boy to Jesus who had five barley loaves and two fish. After Jesus took the loaves and fish, He blessed them and broke them. He gave the pieces to the disciples, and they gave the pieces to the people. There was enough food to feed those thousands of people!
- When the people saw this miracle, they believed that Jesus was the Prophet that God had promised.
